



Waiver of Policy #600-11 Student Housing

Administrative Policy #600-11 Student Housing is being waived for the 2021-2022 academic year. Students receiving Pratt Community College scholarship awards for 2021-2022 are not required to live in the residence halls as part of their scholarship award agreement. This action is being taken to provide students an option for their living arrangements in light of the continuing COVID-19 pandemic.

During 2021-2022, the College will continue to implement numerous safety precautions throughout campus, including the residence halls, to minimize the risk of and exposure to COVID-19. Among other precautions and until further notice, residents will be expected to practice social distancing in commons areas, communal restrooms, and laundry spaces. Face coverings will continue to be required until further notice. Additional guidelines may be implemented based on Federal, State and Local regulations as needed. A community living environment, such a residence hall, does increase potential exposure, and the College wants students to be prepared for adhering to these expectations and restrictions. Students will again be asked to sign a Residence Hall Code of Conduct for COVID-19 Pandemic prior to being allowed to move into the residence hall. With the waiver of Policy #600-11 Student Housing, students in AY 2021-2022 now have an option to live off campus without it impacting their scholarship award.
